

Winsome – Gaff Rigged Sloop



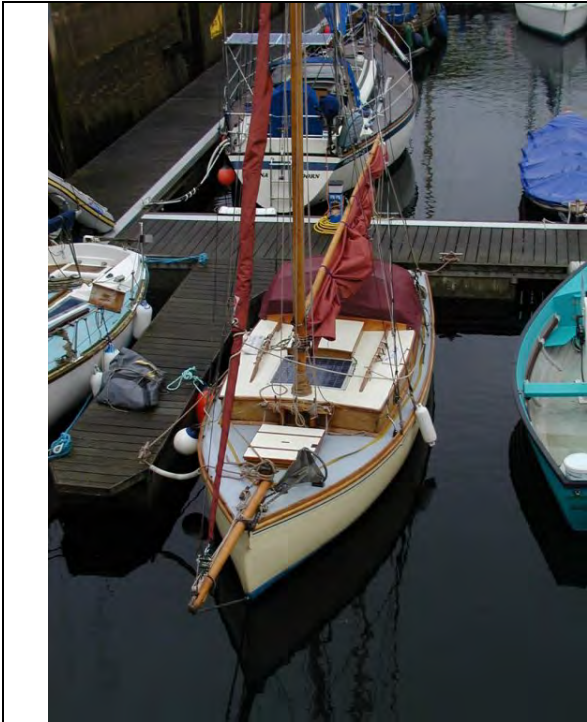
This two berth, Gaff Rigged Sloop is reluctantly offered for sale to a willing buyer. Sensible offers are invited.

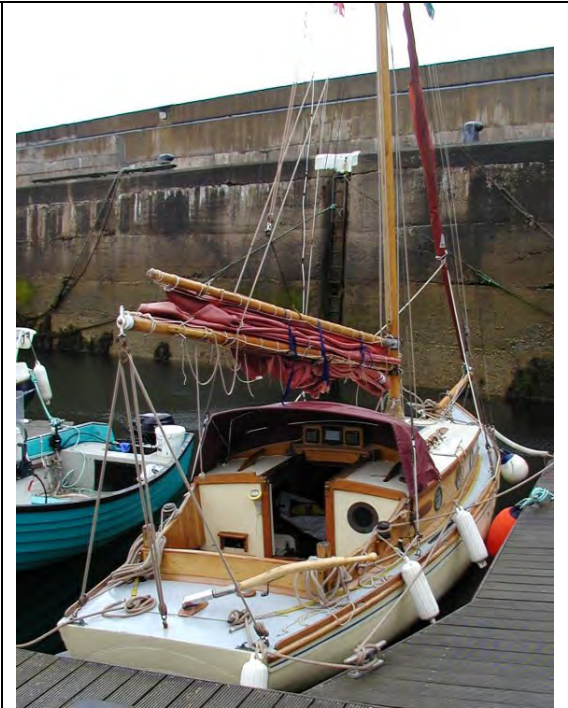
Historical - Winsome's exact age is unknown, however the original hull is thought to date from the early part of the 20th century. She was first constructed as a sail only, half decker with centre board, possibly by a yard in the SE UK. The cabin was added in the 1960s, the centre board removed and replaced with a long ballast keel. The first engine would also have been added at that time or soon after.

Winsome is currently cruising the N.E. coast of Scotland and is based in Nairn.

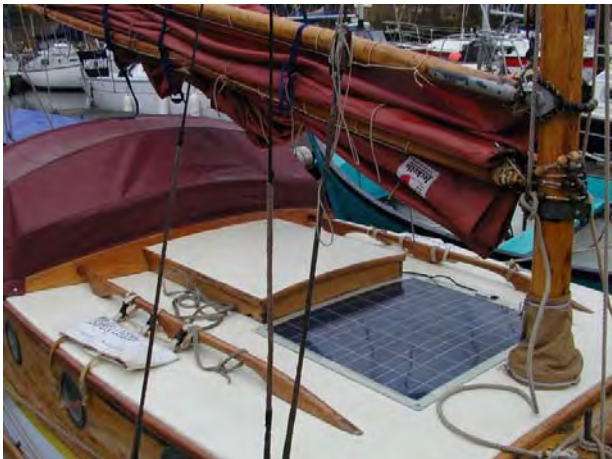

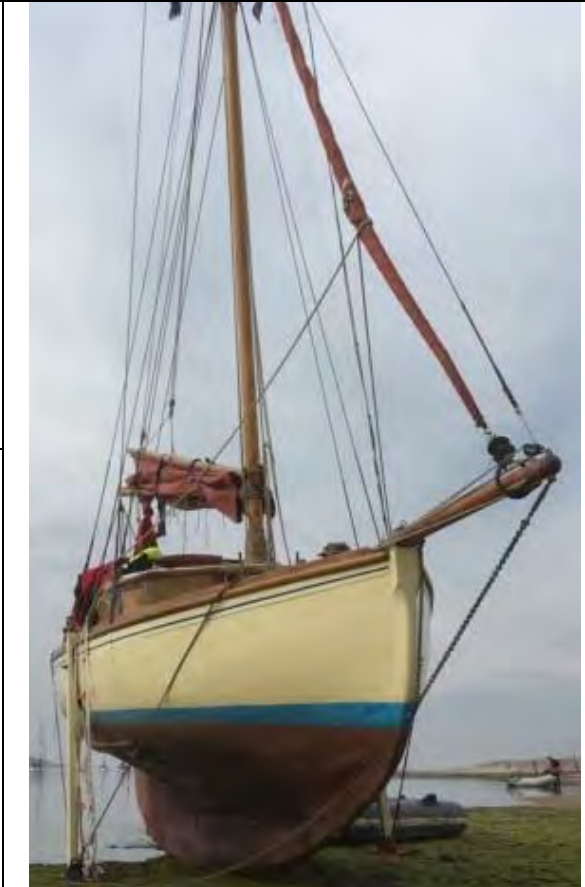
